## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

*The Congressional Art Competition*, launched in 1982, is coordinated by Members of Congress and is an annual high school art competition and exhibition representing congressional districts across the nation. The Best of Show artwork travels to Washington, D.C. to be displayed for one year in the U.S. Capitol Building's Cannon Tunnel with other congressional district winners.

## **TEACHER REQUIREMENTS**

- Entries are limited to **one** per student, each art teacher may enter up to **five** works.
- The **Student Information & Release Form** must be completed and attached to the **back** of each entry.
- Artworks must be transported in a **secure portfolio** and the portfolio labeled with the school's name and the words "*Congressional Art Competition*".
- An **Inventory Sheet and copy of each Release Form** must be completed and forwarded in the portfolio with the student entries.

## 1<sup>ST</sup> PLACE PRIZES

**U.S. Capitol Building Exhibit:** The winner's artwork will be displayed in the Cannon Tunnel for a period of 11 months.

**Framing:** The winning student's artwork will be professionally framed, courtesy of a local frame shop.
